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INTERPOL TECHNOLOGIES FOR SECURITY

Interpol's mission is to help the police in everything the world to cooperate to prevent and fight crime. They provide a high-tech international infrastructure of international support for solving the growing tasks of combating various types of crimes. At the request of member countries, they can provide specialized teams of experts to assist the national police in security matters. These describe some methods of improving security throughout the world, namely Incident Response Teams (IRTs) and Major Event Support Teams (IMESTs) [1].

Interpol Emergency Response Teams are specialized teams that help national law enforcement agencies respond to large-scale problems. They consist of experts from various fields, involved at the request of the country during the crisis. There are two types of such groups: emergency response groups such as natural disasters, security threats, epidemics and other critical circumstances; and groups that specialize in fighting crime and helping countries with serious policing problems.

Response teams can be deployed anywhere in the world within 12-24 hours. They are organized according to the specific nature of the disaster or crime and the requirements of the requesting country, and provide such support as: money laundering expertise, verification of fake passports, access to the database of stolen and lost travel documents, analysis of the fingerprint database or facial recognition, etc.

Interpol Major Event Support Teams are being formed to assist countries in the preparation, coordination and implementation of events security during large high-level events. Events such as high-profile conferences or sporting events attract large crowds and intense media

coverage. As such, they may also attract individuals or groups who intend to disrupt such events with criminal intent purpose The threat of terrorism and disruption forces countries to devote more time and resources to being prepared to deal with any emergency. Increasingly, countries are turning to for help Interpol.

Support teams help national and foreign liaison officers to make the best use of Interpol's databases. They facilitate the real-time exchange of messages and vital police data between countries. This data includes fingerprints, photographs, wanted reports, as well as information on stolen or lost travel documents and stolen cars.

Support groups also have the capacity and resources to act as emergency response teams should they arise during large events.

Modern crimes are becoming more and more international, and it is very important to ensure international coordination of their investigation. Since Interpol is a global organization, it can provide this platform for international cooperation.
