*Professional Training:* For a globally competitive workforce, it is crucial to offer English language courses to civil servants, business professionals, and other key groups. These courses will equip professionals with the skills necessary for effective international communication and collaboration.

*English as a State Exam Subject:* Implementing mandatory English language exams for certain qualifications and public service roles will incentivize students and professionals to attain and maintain high levels of English proficiency, enhancing overall national competency.

*Translation of Educational Documents:* To ensure international recognition of Ukrainian academic qualifications, translating diplomas, certificates, and essential academic documents into English is vital. This measure will facilitate Ukrainian graduates' mobility in global academic and professional arenas.

It is suggested the following streamlined approach to implementing English language use in Ukraine:

*Public Service:* Establishing clear English proficiency requirements across civil service categories, introduce English testing in hiring processes, and offer free or subsidized language courses to public servants.

*Business and Economy:* Encourage Ukrainian companies to join international projects, promote exports by requiring English proficiency for employees in export sectors, and hold English-language forums to attract foreign investment.

*Information Sphere:* Translate all official documents into English, create English-language versions of government and business websites, and expand English-language media in Ukraine.

*Culture and Tourism:* Organize cultural events in English, develop English-language tourism websites and resources, and train English-speaking tour guides.

Additional Measures:

*Language Policy Framework:* Develop a cohesive policy that defines goals and stakeholder responsibilities.

*Resource Allocation:* Allocate funding for English education, training, and infrastructure.

*Public Awareness:* Conduct campaigns promoting English proficiency benefits.

*International Cooperation:* Partner with international organizations to share best practices.
