In this thesis I want to investigate the issue of Ukrainian emigration.

The emigration of a large number of Ukrainians due to a full-scale Russian invasion has become an economic and humanitarian challenge not only for Ukraine but also for partner states that have accepted millions of displaced persons.

Almost 700 days have passed since February 24. Some of the Ukrainians who went abroad have returned home, someone integrated into a new country for society, but there are those who are only traveling outside Ukraine now. And, judging by our data, the number of those who now emigrate is increasing.

Currently, it is clear that returning home to millions of Ukrainian citizens will require considerable effort from the Ukrainian authorities and partner states. First of all, it is about creating favorable security, humanitarian and economic conditions.

Despite the considerable amount of data, it is impossible to determine exactly how many Ukrainians are now abroad. However, it can be stated now that this number is still increasing, including due to regular terrorist actions of Russia. Due to this, it is likely that the population of Ukraine is closer to 35 million than 40 million.

In response to the request of the Civic Network, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs reported that as of June 21, 2023, there were 8 million 177 thousand Ukrainians abroad. Compared to data on February 1, 2023. That is, in less than 5 months, this number increased by almost 188 thousand people.

According to Ukrainian law, internally displaced persons are people who have been forced to leave or leave their place of residence as a result or to avoid the negative consequences of armed conflict, temporary occupation, widespread manifestations of violence, human rights or emergencies.

The Ministry of Social Policy in response to the request of the OPORA Civic Network reported that as of June 9, 2023, 4 871 807 people were registered in Ukraine, of which 60% are women. We emphasize that a full - scale invasion has forced their homes to be 700 people aged 100 or more.

The inclusion of a specific case study on Ukrainian emigration adds depth to the thesis, offering a real-world example of the complexities

associated with migration. The discussion on the increasing number of Ukrainians abroad due to ongoing challenges, such as terrorist actions, provides a timely and relevant context. This case study enhances the applicability of the thesis to current global affairs.
