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**EVOLUTION OF COMMUNICATION LINKAGES OF CONDEMNED
AS THE BASIS OF DEVELOPMENT OF MODERN PRISON SUBCULTURE**

Preventing crime in prison is impossible without consolidation of efforts of law enforcement agencies, governmental agencies, local self-government and the public. We share the opinion of scholars-criminologists that crime prevention among prisoners is connected with coordination between administrative unsubsordinated entities within their common goals and objectives. In addition, these entities interact on the basis of making joint decisions (making suggestions concerning crime counteraction, development of guidelines, etc.); autonomy of everyone within its legal powers and prevention of replacement of one agency with another in the performance of coordination activities; personal responsibility for timely implementation of agreed measures.

The main sources of replenishment of “obshchak” (common fund of a criminal community) in prison are:

1. From 5% to 20% of the winning weekly games “for the game sake” (cards, dominoes, backgammon);
2. Fee of convicted businessmen for personal safety at a rate that depends on the actual level of his wealth;
3. From 20% to 30% of the profits is acquired from the sale of goods “shyropotreb”, which is made out of control of the administration;
4. From 10% to 20% of the earnings of working prisoners (“muzhik”) due to fraudulent employment of trusties;
5. From receipt (if required) of parcels from relatives or other persons, charities, civil and religious organizations.

Thus, the above examples and formulated problems again stress the need for a comprehensive study of the evolution of communication linkages of convicted as the basis of the modern prison subculture.
