

emergency response training, ensuring that communities and critical services are prepared for possible attacks [2]. In addition, the United States has developed systems to restore infrastructure and provide assistance to affected communities after terrorist attacks to minimize the impact on the population and economy [3].

Institutions such as the US Department of Homeland Security (DHS) and the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) are at the forefront of counterterrorism efforts, strategy development, and national security research. An important aspect is international cooperation, which allows the United States not only to protect its borders, but also to fight terrorism on a global level by sharing information and supporting other states in their efforts against extremism [2].

Thus, the US anti-terrorist strategy is a multi-level set of measures that combines both hard methods, such as financial isolation and intelligence, and soft methods aimed at preventing radicalization. This allows the US to effectively counter terrorist threats, ensuring both national security and supporting international efforts to combat global terrorism [1].

ENSURING PUBLIC ORDER AND SAFETY OF CITIZENS IN UKRAINE AND ABROAD

State authorities ensure public order by maintaining peace and the right to assemble in accordance with international human rights standards. Citizens have a democratic right to demonstrate and express dissatisfaction with the government, but in a peaceful way and within the bounds of the law.

Police forces are tasked with maintaining public order when large crowds gather for example at football matches, other cultural and social events, marches, or at political demonstrations. For them, the challenge is to

balance the right to assemble with the need to ensure that order is preserved and people protected.

EUAM cooperates with ICITAP (International Criminal Investigative Training Assistance Program), Agriteam Canada and the European Gendarmerie Force to help the National Police of Ukraine and Ministry of Internal Affairs of Ukraine to implement best European practices in the sphere of public order.

Together with the National Police and international partners, EUAM has established a working group and action plan on public order that sets out five key areas of public-order reform, namely: support to the development of relevant legislation, organisation and administration of public order units, development of internal police regulations and procedures, training of public-order units, and public-order equipment.

Emergency Security Response.

Since Russia's full-scale invasion, Ukraine has prioritized civilian protection, particularly in conflict zones where humanitarian aid is essential. Protecting the 7.1 million internally displaced persons (IDPs) is also critical, as displacement strains local resources and security capacities. Enhanced military and logistical support has improved the Ukrainian armed forces' ability to protect citizens and deliver emergency assistance, although security challenges persist, especially in heavily affected areas.

Support for Refugees and Asylum Seekers in Europe. As millions of Ukrainians fled to neighboring countries, the European Union introduced the Temporary Protection Directive, granting refugees access to health care, education, and employment. This coordinated EU response, which includes financial aid and structured relocation processes, has helped manage the needs of refugees in a safe and organized manner.

Strengthening the Rule of Law and Justice. Ensuring justice and accountability for war crimes has been an integral part of Ukraine's approach. Ukraine, with support from partners like the U.S. Agency for International Development (USAID), has been focused on building a transparent judiciary to handle the surge in conflict-related cases. This effort aims to increase trust in legal institutions and provides a foundation for post-war rebuilding, reinforcing both domestic and international laws to prosecute those responsible for human rights abuses.

National Security Strategy and Reforms. Ukraine's security strategy includes comprehensive reforms to secure territorial integrity, with key efforts in cybersecurity, information warfare, and counter-terrorism. National security policies adopted since 2014 have shifted Ukraine's focus to defending against Russian hybrid warfare, including the transformation of its law enforcement and defense forces into modernized entities like the National Guard.

International Cooperation and Funding. International aid plays a crucial role in Ukraine's security efforts. NATO, the EU, and Western

governments have provided substantial support, from military aid to anti-corruption initiatives aimed at reducing oligarchic influence in government. Continued cooperation with international partners is necessary to maintain Ukraine's sovereignty and resilience against external threats.

This approach underscores the importance of resilience and collaboration in maintaining security and safety for Ukrainians, both at home and abroad, with a view toward sustainable peace and integration with European standards.
