INTERACTION OF THE NATIONAL POLICE OF UKRAINE AND THE NATIONAL GUARD OF UKRAINE DURING MASS EVENTS

During mass events it is necessary to control the order of their holding, namely the prevention of mass riots and other socially dangerous acts. In order to ensure public order and safety of citizens, the National Police interacts with other state bodies that have law enforcement functions, in particular, we will talk about cooperation with the National Guard of Ukraine.

To begin with, it should be noted the definition of the term "mass events". Mass events are events of socio-political, religious, sports, cultural and entertainment nature with the participation of many citizens, held on the occasion of state, professional, religious holidays, anniversaries, as well as at the initiative of political parties, movements, public associations, religious denominations (communities), individual citizens, sports organizations, cultural institutions [1].

Signs of mass events are:

- certain organized activities;
- participation of a significant number of people;
- the event is held in a certain public place;
- the purpose of which is to exercise their rights and freedoms to meet political, physical, spiritual, and other needs.

However, a distinction needs to be made between peaceful events and mass riots, as experience shows that fights take place during a certain event, which escalate into a larger illegal act of many people. Therefore, to prevent these riots, the National Police is tasked with ensuring public safety and order [4]. However, there are cases when one police force is not enough to protect these events, so they involve forces from the National Guard of Ukraine, whose functional responsibilities include participation in public safety and protection of public order during meetings, rallies, marches, demonstrations, and other mass events that endanger the lives and health of citizens [2].

The following are involved in ensuring (protection) of public (public) security and order:

from the National Guard of Ukraine - military units (subdivisions), which are entrusted with the functions of protection of public order;

from the National Police of Ukraine - territorial bodies of the National Police in the Autonomous Republic of Crimea and the city of Sevastopol, oblasts and the city of Kyiv, their separate subdivisions.

This interaction is carried out within the limits set by law, namely by:

- joint patrols of streets, squares, parks, squares, railway stations, airports, sea and river ports, other public (public) places;

- ensuring (protection) of public (public) security and order during meetings, rallies, street marches, demonstrations, other mass, and sports events, as well as during events in public (public) places with the participation of persons subject to state protection;

- Carrying out of joint actions for the purpose of stabilization of an operational situation in case of its aggravation within the territory of one or several administrative-territorial units [3].

Sometimes there are situations when the measures get out of control and several people behave aggressively and start a fight, thus provoking other people. As a result, there are mass riots, accompanied by restrictions on certain human rights and freedoms. Therefore, the police are moving to an intensified regime of official activities. Direct management of the involved forces and means, organization of interaction, collection and analysis of operational information and its exchange is carried out by the heads of the National Police of Ukraine, the Main Directorate of the National Police, relevant divisions of territorial bodies of the National Police of Ukraine or their deputies according to the competence of those services introduction of an enhanced regime, including the National Guard of Ukraine. If technically possible, during joint activities with other law enforcement agencies or military formations, police officers who are transferred to a reinforced regime work on a single radio channel. Comprehensive support (moral and psychological, medical, logistical, communication) of police officers involved in the period of the enhanced version, is entrusted to the police authority in accordance with its competence and is carried out in accordance with applicable law [5].

In order to eliminate the mass riots, law enforcement agencies operate in the following order:

1. Register messages in the prescribed manner;
3. Immediately report to the chief of the police body (subdivision), his deputies (according to the division of functional responsibilities), the responsible police body (subdivision) (to the chief of the patrol police response sector) and to the next higher level service;
4. By the decision of the chief of the body (subdivision) of the police, a special operational plan "Wave" shall be put into effect and shall act in accordance with this plan and the instructions of the head of the police operation;
5. Inform the duty prosecutor's office, territorial body (subdivision) of the Security Service of Ukraine, other bodies of state power and local self-government.
6. After the end of the police operation, the next high-level service is informed about its results [6].

Thus, we considered the issues of cooperation between the National Police of Ukraine and the National Guard of Ukraine during mass events, also focused on the organization of this interaction and the algorithm of action to stop the riots. The protection of mass events is a necessary component for certain public events because aggressive people appear during events to prevent the event or even the

beginning of major riots, which can lead to the acts of vandalism, thereby violating public order and safety of citizens. Therefore, the police control the course of mass events and, if necessary, involve the National Guard of Ukraine, because, as stated in the Constitution of Ukraine, a person, his life and health, honor and dignity, inviolability and security are the highest social value for the state.
