**INFORMATION WAR AS AN TOOL OF WAR PROPAGANDA:
LEGAL GROUNDS OF COUNTERACTION**

Actuality of theme. Globalization and the information technology revolution have become integrators of classic and new forms, means, methods and technologies of war. Currently, Ukraine is actually in a state of information war, as it is constantly the object of informational aggression, propaganda and pressure in all spheres of social relations from Russia. That is why, in such conditions, the development and simultaneous approbation of mechanisms and means of countering such propaganda will mark their effectiveness.

Russian aggression towards Ukraine is an indisputable fact that does not cause doubts, but requires an appropriate response. Today, such a reaction is insufficient mainly due to the fact that the aggression of one state against another requires, at a minimum, the following things: first, a clear identification of the nature, scope and causes of such aggression; secondly, it is necessary not only to counteract the aggression itself, but also to prevent its spread, including in the middle of the country, which requires the creation of an appropriate organizational and legal system within the national framework, which, again, requires certainty at the level of categorical and terminological device

Research status. International legal aspects of war propaganda and information warfare have been the subject of scientific analysis by domestic and foreign researchers such as Y. Malik, O. Frolova, S. Lyulko, M. Zinchenko, M. Kearney, T. McGonagle, G. Michael, D. Box. The purpose of the study is to

analyze countermeasures and prevention of war propaganda and informational threats in Ukraine.

Presenting main material. Considering the fact that at the international legal level, the information war has not yet received the necessary consolidation and development at the level of the categorical apparatus, although it is recognized as incompatible with the steady development of the enemy, the aggressive activity of the subjects of international law, however, the international community has not taken practical measures to counter it developed Such a situation does not mean the ineffectiveness or low level of effectiveness of international legal measures and means of countering war propaganda, but we are convinced of their inadequacy.

According to O.O. Vergolyas, the current level of intensification of war propaganda activities turns it into a major informational threat. That is, on the negative informational impact of a technical or psychological nature, which makes it impossible or difficult to preserve national values. And that is why we can testify that the propaganda of war has turned into an independent means of waging war of a new formation - informational and hybrid war [1].

We agree with the scientist's opinion that "information war is a set of purposeful informational influences carried out by the subject of influence on informational systems or social processes using information technology means, informational resources and communications by creating factors that inhibit sustainable development or transform the stability of the state, society, a person with the aim of achieving dominance, superiority, monopoly in various segments of human existence" [2]. Therefore, we consider it expedient to continue researching the current issue at the doctrinal level.

On this occasion, A. Golovka emphasizes that the low level of the ability to resist information threats, as well as the low quality of criminal prosecution for the commission of crimes of war propaganda, is the result of "incompleteness of the process of forming the regulatory and legal framework for ensuring information security, therefore, we consider it necessary to return to the issue of adopting a single legislative act in the field of countering information threats to Ukraine, countering and prosecuting war propaganda and ensuring information security in Ukraine. This law should incorporate the main principles, including international legal principles, regarding the implementation of information security, the minimization of military and other threats in terms of countering war propaganda and any discrimination against the Ukrainian state, the Ukrainian people, etc. [3].

Attention should be paid to the need to develop, along with the Information Security Doctrine, the National Mental Health Protection Strategy. Obviously, it is about the fact that by negatively influencing the human consciousness and the public consciousness in general by means of war propaganda, there is a deformation of the public perception of the role of the state, the growth of a persistent conviction of the inability of the state to protect its own sovereignty and create conditions for stable national security.

Therefore, we come to the conclusion that the legal consolidation of any mechanisms, measures, means of international legal responsibility or measures to counter propaganda of war must necessarily have appropriate support at the level of national legislation.
