**Value of General Principles and the Rule of Law
as the Principal Legal Doctrines**

In the article highlights the problem of correlation of principles and the rule of law in modern Ukrainian legal reality. It was found that the general principles and the rule of law in positivistics doctrine

identified. Emphasized the primacy and determination general principles of law regarding the law jus in naturalistic doctrine.
