

The OSCE also conducts special events aimed at cadets. The event is organized within the framework of the project of the OSCE Project Coordinator in Ukraine "Proliferation of the National Mechanism for the Interaction of Entities Carrying Out Actions in the Field of Combating Human Trafficking in Ukraine", which is implemented with the financial support of the governments of Canada and the USA. The overall goal of the project is to strengthen the capacity of state authorities in the field of combating human trafficking, as well as to strengthen the capacity of state bodies and public organizations to provide appropriate assistance to victims of human trafficking [4].

All these trends really improve the ability of Ukrainian law enforcement officers to solve crimes aimed at human trafficking. Although the way of our Motherland in the direction of full democracy and the political course towards European countries and the USA is already clearly recognized, still the old methods and approaches of combating crimes are existed, but the young specialists are increasingly moving away from them.

ANALYTIC ACTIVITIES OF SPECIAL INTELLIGENCE AUTHORITIES OF THE USA

It is common knowledge that today the United States of America (hereinafter – the USA) has the largest and most effective intelligence a system in which analytical intelligence is preferred. The main analytical activity is closely related to the development of development strategies and programs, waging psychological warfare, maintaining and expanding the system of influence.

Analytical intelligence is a mandatory part of intelligence activity, which consists of detection, assessment, analysis and forecasting various social processes, events, activities based on information obtained mainly from open sources or based on the results of the implementation intelligence activities of other types.

The Central Intelligence Agency of the United States (hereinafter - the CIA) consists of directorates that, in addition to agency intelligence and active operations, have the right to conduct analytical research. One of the directorates is called "Directorate of Analysis" (Directorate of Analysis), the main tasks of which are:

- a warning about the threat of using nuclear weapons or brewing a critical state of affairs that can turn into a massive armed conflict;
- formation of daily intelligence files and weekly reports on the state of affairs for the president of the country, vice prime minister, etc.;
- providing US embassies with intelligence information;
- analysis, assessment and forecast of military, political, scientific and other problems.

The structure of the Analytical Directorate is built in order to fully ensure the execution of the above-mentioned tasks [1].

The approximate structure of the CIA Analytical Directorate known from open sources is as follows:

- CIA Operations Center (round-the-clock structuring and processing of information for the purpose of identifying signs of emerging crisis situations that threaten US national security);
 - Management of current products and provision of analytical work (preparation and publication of informational materials for the Directorate and design of maps, schemes and schedules necessary to ensure the conduct of CIA briefings);
 - Directorate of scientific research and research in the field of weapons (analysis of technical aspects of weapons and space systems of other countries, as well as information about nuclear weapons, nuclear energy, tactical and strategic weapons, air defense systems, etc.);
 - Management of global problems (consideration of economic, geographical and technological problems of an international scale, such as terrorism, epidemics, transnational crime, environmental disasters etc);
 - Management of information resources (information and reference functions, processing of large data sets, organization of the archive, provision of access to information, provision of data protection, search and distribution information);
 - Department of analysis of information about foreign leaders (study actions of foreign political leaders, their biographies, political views, decision-making style, as well as influencing factors);

- Department for providing leadership and analytical work (administrative support of the Directorate's leadership, coordination of work with other divisions);
- Department for preparation of tasks and assessments (determination of priorities of the Directorate's work, development of information analysis methods);
- Arms Control Department (study and analysis of supplies weapons, proliferation of weapons of mass destruction, development of arms control).

The structure of regional offices of the Directorate is also of interest, which consists of the Department of Information Analysis for Russia and Europe; Management of the analysis of information on the Middle East and South Asia; Management of the analysis of information on Iraq; Management of information analysis on countries of Africa and Latin America.

The National Intelligence Council was created and operates in the CIA, which includes both civilian and military specialists. The main strategic task of the National Intelligence Council is to prepare a report under called "Global Trends" (Global Trends) for the future president of the United States every four years. The purpose of the board's work is to prepare and present factual, unvarnished information, regardless of whether the analytical findings are consistent with current US policy. In the light of the pre-election presidential processes, Global Trends reports are very important value.

Special intelligence agencies in the USA carry out round-the-clock monitoring of important intelligence information that comes to the State Department, the Ministry of War and the CIA. Separately assigned officers review the information for discovery any facts of aggravation of the situation. They have a direct duty communication to inform the direct managers who decide who from the top political leadership should be informed - from the president to responsible for the defense of the country.

So, we can draw a conclusion - the activity of state analytical agencies intelligence agencies is important for the national security of the state several reasons: assessment of the current situation and identification of threats to the state; forecasting to make timely and effective decisions for protection of national interests; providing support when making management decisions in the field of defense, foreign policy, economy and other areas of public administration.
