## **INTERACTION OF THE MINISTRY OF INTERNAL AFFAIRS WITH THE NATIONAL GUARD OF UKRAINE**

Ensuring public security and order is one of the priority tasks of the National Police of Ukraine and is of great importance to the state, especially during martial law. There are a number of peculiarities of

ensuring public safety and order both independently by the bodies and units of the National Police of Ukraine and in cooperation with other authorized law enforcement agencies and volunteer paramilitary groups under martial law. In order to strengthen the activities of the National Police of Ukraine under martial law, it is essential to provide all necessary supplies and to ensure the mobile readiness of its employees.

The National Police of Ukraine, as a central executive body, serves the public by ensuring the protection of human rights and freedoms, combating crime, maintaining public order and public safety. Under martial law, the powers of the National Police have been significantly expanded from the security and defense sector to direct tasks related to ensuring public safety and order in Ukraine. Article 3 of the Constitution of Ukraine stipulates that a person, his or her life, health, honor, dignity, inviolability, and security are recognized as the greatest social value.

The National Guard of Ukraine is a military formation with law enforcement functions, which is part of the system of the Ministry of Internal Affairs of Ukraine and is intended to perform tasks to protect and defend the lives, rights, freedoms and legitimate interests of citizens, society and the state from criminal and other unlawful attacks, to protect public order and ensure public safety, as well as in cooperation with law enforcement agencies to ensure state security and protect the state border. Interaction between the National Guard of Ukraine and the National Police of Ukraine is carried out within the limits established by law, including the Order of September 07, 2016 "On Approval of the Organization of Interaction between the National Guard of Ukraine and the National Police of Ukraine in Ensuring (Protecting) Public Safety and Order", namely through joint patrols of streets, squares, parks, squares, railway stations, airports, sea and river ports, and other public places; ensuring (protecting) public safety and order during meetings, rallies, street marches, demonstrations, other mass and sporting events, as well as during events in public places with the participation of persons subject to state protection, holding joint events to stabilize the operational situation in case of its aggravation within the territory of one or more administrative-territorial units.

In the territories where martial law has been introduced, to ensure the operation of the Constitution and laws of Ukraine, to ensure, together with the military command, the introduction and implementation of measures of the legal regime of martial law, defense, civil protection, public safety and order, protection of critical infrastructure, protection of the rights, freedoms and legitimate interests of citizens. Despite the fact that these forms of interaction between the National Guard of Ukraine and the National Police of Ukraine are used in everyday life, they are currently key to ensuring order in the country during martial law.

Due to the ongoing exchange of experience with similar structures of foreign formations, from August 1, 2019, the NGU units began to use foot patrols in their powers to perform public order and security tasks, thus interacting with the National Police of Ukraine. The police may also use preventive police measures while performing public order protection, including document checks, vehicle stops, questioning of persons, police custody, and the use of technical devices with photo and video recording functions.

As a rule, the National Guard of Ukraine assists the police in checkpoints and foot patrols, thus protecting public safety for the peaceful life of Ukrainian citizens. They monitor the organization of control over compliance with special transportation regimes under martial law in accordance with the Law of Ukraine "On the Legal Regime of Martial Law". They also organize high-quality interaction with civil protection authorities and public authorities in the event of an emergency.

In summary, I believe that the National Guard of Ukraine and the National Police of Ukraine make a great contribution to the protection of order and the protection of Ukrainian citizens and work closely together to improve the results of these activities.
